Providing FamilyWize Prescription Discount Cards to the community, saving local residents an average of 40% on prescription drug costs.

Coordinating the West Central Connecticut TRIAD Program, which strives to improve the quality of life for older residents.

### HOW UNITED WAY IS WINNING:

Providing free books for children from low-income families. Helping to ensure that all children enter kindergarten ready to learn.

Helping middle school students transition to high school and young adulthood.

Encouraging high school students to become leaders and address issues important to their peers.

Providing youth with paid summer work experiences and career development opportunities.
